NEW STUDENTS

New students not yet registered should report to the school office. All new students will be taken to temporary age-appropriate classrooms for the morning and will return to the gym for pick up at 12:00 noon. Starting the next day, new students will return to their temporary classrooms each day until regular classes are formed. Students will be informed as to which door they should be dropped off and picked up from. If you have any questions please come to the office.
