NEW STUDENTS

Please plan to be at the school before the first bell which rings at 8:55 am. On our first day, if you are already registered you will be welcomed in our school gym. New students not yet registered should report to the school office. All new students will be taken to temporary age-appropriate classrooms for the morning and will return to the gym for pick up at 12:00 noon. Starting the next day, new students will return to their temporary classrooms each day until regular classes are formed. Students will be informed as to which door they should be dropped off and picked up from. If you have any questions please come to the office.

RETURNING STUDENTS

Please plan to be at the school before the first bell which rings at 8:55 am. Students should line up at the door they came through in June. Our grade 1 students (**last year's K's**) will be met at their old door and will be brought to the library. They will be returned to the same doors for dismissal. Students in grades 2-7 will be taken to their last year's classrooms until regular classes are formed.
