- We do our best to meet requests, however, there is no guarantee to meet all requests.
- Finally, please make sure to submit your requests in writing. A conversation with a classroom teacher is not a substitute for a request.

Regional/District Track Meet:

Congratulations to all our track students. We had 52 students make it to the District Track Meet-amazing efforts!!! The following students placed at the District's: our grade 4 boys shuttle relay team placed 1st, and the grade 4 mixed relay team placed 2nd.
